





Hi Everyone,

Season 2016/17 will be here soon and I wanted to take this chance to update everyone on what we have been up to lately.

As I hope you all know, we have had 3 fantastic seasons that have seen the club grow to 6 (maybe 7) senior sides, 10 junior sides including 2 girls teams, juniors in every age group from Milo In2Cricket to Under 18s and a vibrant social community. On the field we have had amazing success with 8 Premierships in the last 3 seasons, more than the previous 20 seasons combined. Our flagship First XI have, amazingly, won premierships in each of these seasons and are now back in Macintosh Shield for the first time in over 10 years.

This is a wonderful turnaround and the Club is now bigger than it has ever been. We often fill the social rooms on Friday nights with all our Junior families and are now faced with challenges around how to manage so many people efficiently and effectively.

#### Be Involved on the field:

  - o For example, if you see rubbish, pick it up. If something is left out, put it away
- If you have a good idea, mention it and be prepared to be part of the team to implement
- Be part of the solution not just aware of the problem
